

Forest Stewardship Council Self-Declaration

Ref: FSC-POL-01-004 v3-0 Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC

The signing organisation is associated with the Forest Stewardship Council A.C., Oaxaca, Mexico, or one of its subsidiaries or affiliates (hereinafter: FSC) by being either a member of or having a contractual relationship with FSC. Hereby the signing Organisation explicitly states that it has read and understood the "Policy for the Association of Organisations with FSC" as published under www.fsc.org. This policy stipulates FSC's position with regards to unacceptable activities by organisations and individuals which already are or would like to be associated with FSC as well as the mechanism for disassociation.

In light of the above, the organisation explicitly agrees currently and, in the future, as long as the relationship with FSC exists, not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- a) Illegal harvesting or illegal trade in forest products.
- b) Violation of customary or human rights within the forestry or forest products sector
- c) Violation of *workers' rights* and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work within the forestry or *forest products sector*
- d) Destruction of High Conservation Values* (HCVs) in forests or High Conservation Value areas
- e) Conversion of natural forest cover
- f) Use of *genetically modified* organisms in forestry operations for any other purposes than research

Additionally, the organisation is committed to have appropriate policies, processes and procedures in place and that they are maintained to avoid any engagement in relevant unacceptable activities listed above.
